Foothills Jeep Tour

Explore the foothills above Colorado Springs by jeep! A driver will meet you at the Broadmoor in an open-sided 4-wheel drive jeep. Within minutes, you will be on a winding mountain road that will take you through spectacular overlooks of Colorado Springs, Cheyenne Canyon, Manitou Springs and Garden of the Gods. United States Air Force Academy & Garden of the Gods Tour

The USAFA is set against the Rampart Range of the Rocky Mountains, providing a beautiful setting for this 18,000-acre property that houses over 4,000 cadets. During the Academy tour, you will see the Visitor's Center and an authentic B-52 that served a tour in Vietnam, along with the world-famous Academy Chapel. Touring the USAFA will show you a glimpse of a cadet's life, their education and military responsibilities as well as the intensity of their training. The Academy is the most visited of all man-made attractions in the state of Colorado and shouldn't be missed by any visitor to the Pikes Peak Region. Leaving the Academy, you will head southwest to the Garden of the Gods, one of the most breathtakingly scenic spots in the entire state of Colorado. Once prime hunting grounds for the Ute Indians, this park offers a taste of Colorado's colorful history combined with stunningly beautiful scenery.

High Tea at Glen Eyrie Castle

Immerse yourself in Old World elegance as you enjoy high tea at Glen Eyrie Castle, a jewel of the Front Range where towering rock formations graced with natural forest amid picturesque landscaping provide a breathtaking setting for the castle itself. When you arrive, you will enjoy a fun and informative tour of this nearly century-old Tudor castle, which was built by General William Jackson Palmer, founder of Colorado Springs. After the tour is complete, the party will adjourn to one of the Castle's beautifully appointed rooms for a traditional English Cream Tea. Upon leaving the castle, guests will ride through the Garden of the Gods, majestic natural sandstone formations that are visible against the backdrop of the Front Range from virtually everywhere in Colorado Springs. Maintained by the city as a natural park since 1909, Garden of the Gods is a must-see for any visitor to Colorado Springs.

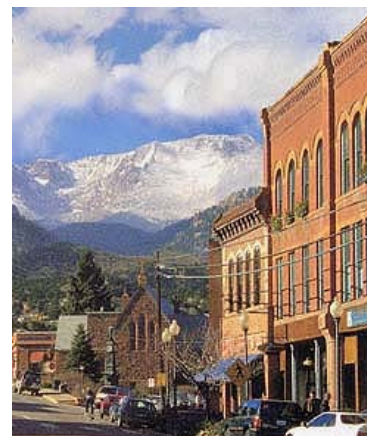

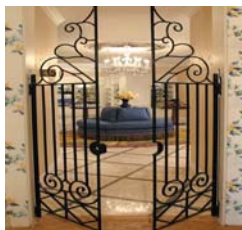
Historical Walking Tour of Manitou Springs
